
GETTING HERE

BY CAR FROM THE WEST


Follow A38 to the Manadon roundabout. Take the A386 ramp to City centre/Tavistock. Slight left onto Outland Rd/A386. Continue to follow A386. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Pennycomequick Hill. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Western Approach/A37. Turn left onto Union St.

At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Derrys Cross. Turn right to stay on Derrys Cross. The Plymouth Athenaeum is on the left

If travelling via the Torpoint Ferry, follow A374 to Union Street. Continue straight onto A374. Turn left on to Pottery Road and follow A374. Turn right onto Park Ave. At the




roundabout, take the second exit onto Edgcumbe Street. Go through two roundabouts on to Union Street and follow to Derry's Cross. Take the third exit onto Derry's Cross, turn right to stay on Derry's Cross. The Plymouth Athenaeum is on the left.



GETTING HERE

FROM THE NORTH

Follow the A386 to Manadon roundabout and Outland Road and follow the directions **FROM THE WEST**.



FROM THE EAST

From the A38 at the Marsh Mills roundabout take the A374, towards Plymouth city centre, at the Charles Cross roundabout turn left towards the bus station onto Exeter Street, go straight over the next roundabout onto Royal Parade. Plymouth Athenaeum is located in the city centre on Derry's Cross roundabout at the intersection of Royal Parade and Union Street.

BY TRAIN

Plymouth central rail station is situated on North Road (PL4 6AB), which is a 15-minute walk from The Plymouth Athenaeum. From the station, follow Armada Way to Royal Parade, follow Royal Parade (west) to Derry's Cross.

Plymouth CityBus service 36 runs from Railway Station Saltash Road to Derry's Cross South, Monday to Friday, during term time.


BY COACH OR BUS

Coaches to Plymouth terminate at Bretonside Bus and Coach Station (PL4 0BG). It is a 10-minute walk along Royal Parade, past the Theatre Royal to Derry's Cross.

Local bus services (see bus company timetables) terminate at Royal Parade and Derry's Cross.

Service 16 runs from Railway Station Saltash Road to Royal Parade Monday to Sunday Services 32/32A/32B run from Railway Station Saltash Road to Royal Parade on weekends.


Long-term/commuter, surface, car park with more than 70 spaces next to The Plymouth Athenaeum.

Blue badge holders can park for free in this car park.

Tariff – Pay and Display.

Charging period Monday to Sunday including bank/public holidays: 8am-10pm.





THEATRE ROYAL

PLI 2TR

Short and long stay, multi-storey, car park, with more than 610 spaces close to the city centre.

Tariff – Pay on Foot (you can either prepay in advance or pay on exit).

Open Monday to Sunday 8am to 11.59pm. (Customers who are parked after midnight will be able to exit.)

Full charges apply to all drivers, including blue badge holders and motorcycles.



CIVIC CENTRE

PLI 2EW

Short-term, surface car park, with more than 100 spaces close to the city centre.

Blue badge holders can park for free in this car park. Maximum stay three hours.

Tariff – Pay and Display.

Daytime charging period Monday to Sunday including bank/public holidays: 8am to 6pm. Evening charging period Monday to Sunday including bank/public holidays: 6pm to 10pm. No maximum stay.

COLIN CAMPBELL COURT

PLI IPZ

Short-term/shoppers, surface, car park with more than 250 spaces close to the city centre.

Daytime maximum stay three hours no return within one hour, including disabled badge holders.

Daytime charging period Monday to Sunday including bank/public holidays: 8am to 6pm Evening charging period Monday to Sunday including bank/public holidays: 6pm to 10pm. No maximum stay.

WESTERN APPROACH

PLI IAJ

Short and long stay, multi storey, car park, with more than 1,000 spaces close to the city centre.

Charging period Monday to Sunday including bank/public holidays: 8am to 10pm.

Full charges apply to all drivers, including blue badge holders and motorcycles.





PLYMOUTH PAVILIONS

Car park next to the Pavilions leisure complex.

It is a six-minute walk along Millbay Road, The Crescent and Athenaeum Lane to The Plymouth Athenaeum.

Charging period is Monday to Sunday including bank/public holidays: 8am to 10pm.

PARKING

PARK AND RIDE

First Devon and Cornwall operate all three park and ride sites in Plymouth: Coypool, the George and Milehouse. Services Monday to Saturday (excluding bank holidays) every 10-15 minutes. Return park and ride services depart from stops A11 and A12 on Royal Parade.

COYPOOL PARK AND RIDE – PR2

COYPOOL ROAD PL7 4TB

A 15-minute journey to Plymouth city centre. Alight at Royal Parade (stop A11).





GEORGE PARK AND RIDE – PRI

TAVISTOCK ROAD PL6 7HB

A 25-minute journey to Plymouth city centre. Alight at Royal Parade (stop A12).

MILEHOUSE PARK AND RIDE – PRI

OUTLAND ROAD PL2 3DE

A 10-minute journey to Plymouth city centre. Alight at Royal Parade (stop A12).
