Cancellation policy

Before your course begins - The deposit of £150 is non-refundable. If you decide to cancel
your course before the course begins, the remainder of the fee may be refunded as follows.

If you inform Mayflower College:

30 days before start date	100%	15-29 days before start date	85%
7-14 days before start date	70%	1-6 days before start date	50%

During your course

- If a student does not attend the course or is absent due to illness, there will be no refund.
- If a student wishes to take a holiday, shorten their course or reduce the number of hours
tuition, they will receive:

75% cash refund or 100% credits for a future course, if the school is informed at least
3 weeks before the change is due to be made.

If a student informs the college of a change, less than 3 weeks before the change is
due to be made, they will not receive any cash or credits.

A "retainer" fee is payable to host families if students vacate their accommodation for a
temporary period.

Travelling from London to Plymouth

"Meet & Greet Services"

You will be met in the Arrivals Hall at Heathrow or Gatwick Airport and escorted to your departure point (i.e. train or coach station) for your onward travel to Plymouth. The escort will NOT travel with you to Plymouth. The price includes the Meet and Greet service but not your travel expenses (see Travelling to Plymouth by bus / train).

Heathrow: escort to Bus Station for onward travel to Plymouth	£32 - £50
Gatwick: escort to Bus Station for onward travel to Plymouth	£32 - £50

Please note that children under 14 cannot travel alone on the bus to Plymouth, although they can travel by train to Plymouth. Escorts are available from Heathrow and Gatwick for onward journey to Plymouth by train - please ask for further details. Alternatively we can arrange for a private taxi to escort from the airport direct to Plymouth.

● Gatwick to Plymouth

Adult return fare £34 - £45 / Child (under 16 years) return fare £21 - £23 (Journey time approximately 5 hours (change bus at Heathrow))

Approximate times of departures from Gatwick: 07.05h, 09.50h, 11.20h, 14.20h, 15.50h, (Friday & Sunday only) 21.50h

● Heathrow to Plymouth
