Travelling from London to Plymouth

"Meet & Greet Services"

You will be met in the Arrivals Hall at Heathrow or Gatwick Airport and escorted to your departure point (i.e. train or coach station) for your onward travel to Plymouth. The escort will NOT travel with you to Plymouth. The price includes the Meet and Greet service but not your travel expenses (see Travelling to Plymouth by bus / train).

Heathrow: escort to Bus Station for onward travel to Plymouth	£32 - £47

Please note that children under 14 cannot travel alone on the bus to Plymouth, although they can travel by train to Plymouth.
