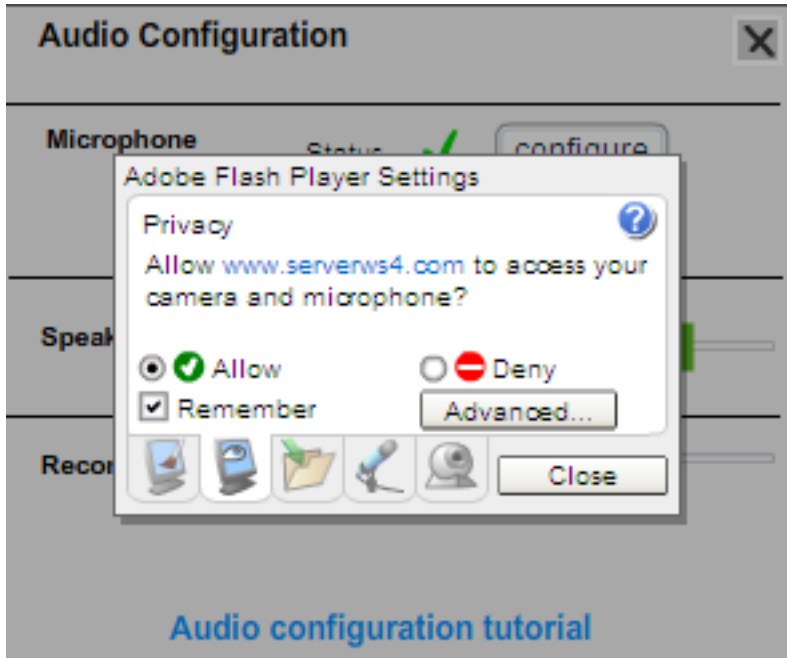

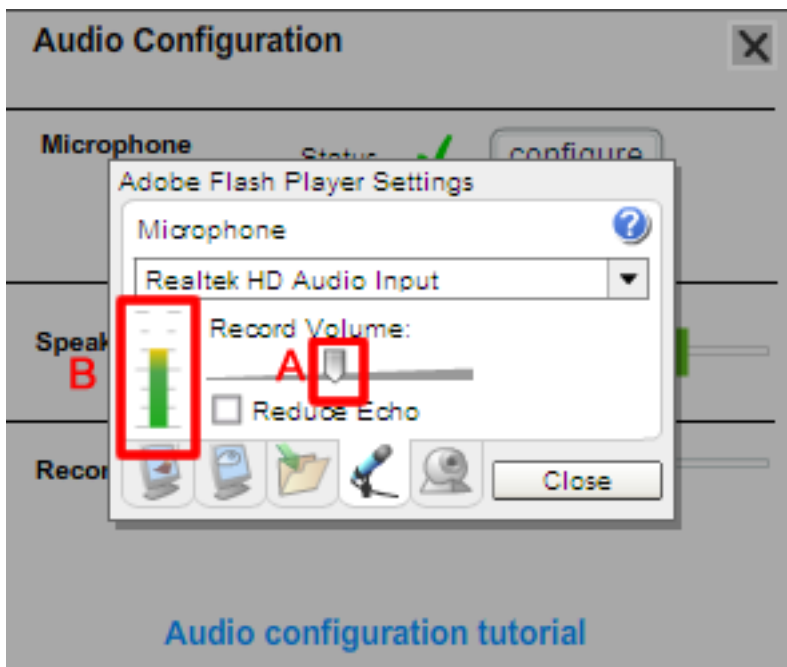
3) Select Microphone / Status / configure: Are “Allow” and “Remember” checked?



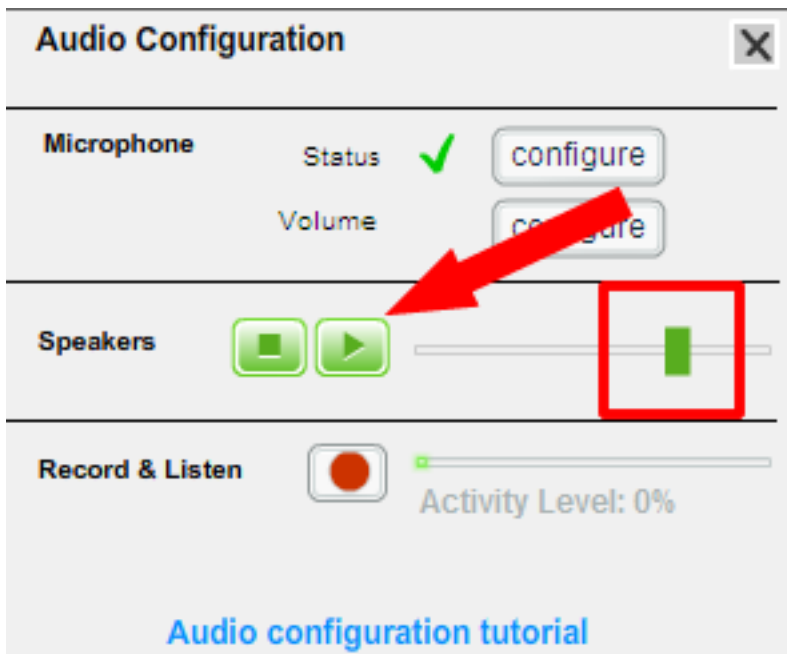
4) Select Microphone / Volume / configure.

A) Is the Record Volume at 50% or more?

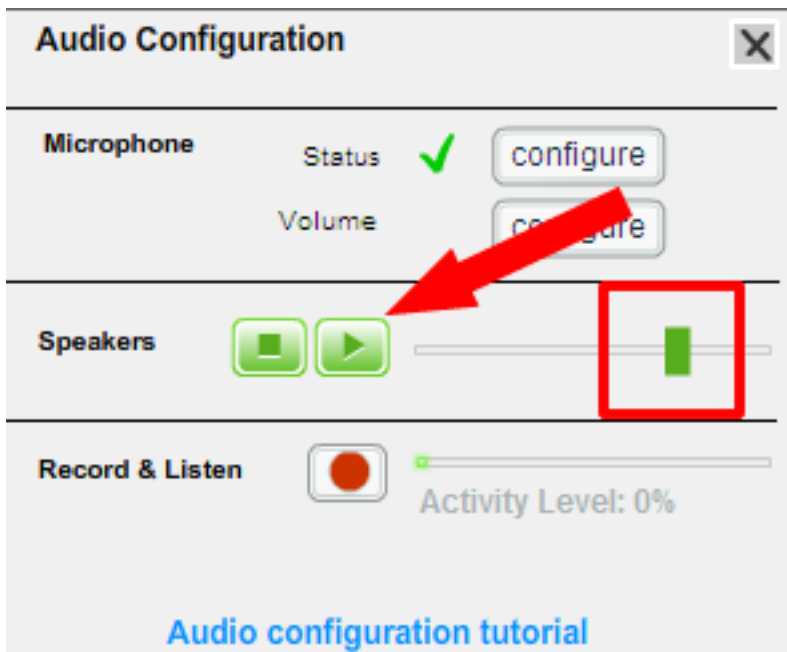
B) When you speak into the microphone does the level meter move?



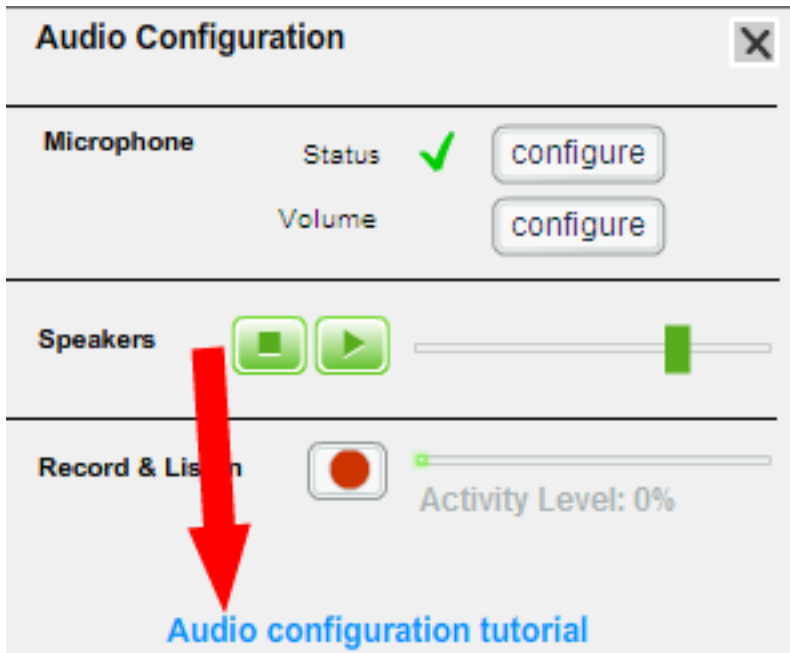
5) Click the “play” button. Do you hear sound?
