Plymouth (population 275,000) is a city of history, beauty and pleasure combining the old with the new; it has something for everyone – culture, entertainment, history and exciting activities.

Visit the Barbican and see the Mayflower steps where the Pilgrim Fathers set sail to America in 1620 on a ship called 'The Mayflower'.

See the beautiful landscape of Dartmoor - a place full of history with its stone circles, Bronze Age ruins and its own collection of myths and legends.

Plymouth's city centre has a wide range of shops for all budgets as well as a large selection of restaurants, cafes and bars.

With its world-famous harbour Plymouth offers many possibilities to have fun on the water such as canoeing, sailing, diving and windsurfing. Other attractions include swimming pools, sports centres, golf courses, cinemas, bowling, casinos, arts centres, libraries, museums, theatres and dry-ski slope / toboggan run.

Plymouth's size means that it has a great deal to offer while managing to avoid many of the social problems found in some of England's larger cities. In addition, there are very few language schools in Plymouth. This means that unlike Bournemouth, Brighton, London, Oxford, Cambridge, etc. there are relatively few foreign students in Plymouth. Consequently there is far more opportunity for students to speak English and far less temptation to speak their native language.

## **Mayflower College**

### Accommodation

To give adult students the maximum opportunity to practise their English in a real-life situation, Mayflower College can arrange accommodation in one of our carefully selected homestays. All of our homestays are inspected and monitored by our Accommodation Officers.

The homestay provides adult students with their own private bedroom, meals (breakfast and dinner from Monday to Friday, breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday and Sunday) and the warmest of welcomes. Light laundry, bed linen and towels are provided. Homestays normally meet students upon arrival and take them to their departure point (in Plymouth).

Homestays are a short bus ride (15-20 minutes) from the Mayflower College; travel passes can be purchased from the main office.

It is our policy not to accommodate more than one person of the same native language in the same host family (unless specifically requested).

Advice can also be provided about other types of accommodation (for example, guest houses and hotels within walking distance of Mayflower College).

### Courses for adults

Students may choose to study for 15 or 25 hours per week. We offer courses for students from elementary to advanced level (but not for complete beginners). These courses concentrate on improving our students' confidence, fluency and accuracy in using all aspects of the language, including:

- A comprehensive coverage of grammar.


